Make the most of what you've got: However, the waste charity [Wrap](#) argues
that second-hand purchases are unlikely to replace more than 10% of new
sales. It recommends other approaches, such as encouraging people to repair
and revamp existing pieces.

Each year in the UK we send 350,000 tonnes of clothing to landfill but by
buying second hand, buying better and buying less and finding new ways to
style the clothes you already own, you can help change things. The most
sustainable clothes are the ones already in your wardrobe. Extending the
lifespan of a garment by nine months can reduce its carbon footprint by 20-
30 per cent.
